

# Knitting Pattern Kp336 Baby Garter Stitch Cardigan 3mths 6mths UK Terminology

## Overview

This knitting pattern is for a baby garter stitch cardigan in sizes 3 months and 6 months. The pattern is written in UK terminology and uses basic knitting stitches. The cardigan is a simple and easy-to-follow pattern, making it perfect for beginner knitters.

## Materials

- Yarn: DK weight yarn in your desired color (approx. 200g for 3mths, 250g for 6mths)
- Needles: 4mm (US 6) knitting needles
- Buttons: 3 or 4 buttons for closure
- Tapestry needle

## Gauge

20 stitches and 28 rows to 10cm (4 inches) in garter stitch using 4mm (US 6) needles.

## Abbreviations

- k: knit
- p: purl
- st(s): stitch(es)
- rep: repeat
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- CO: cast on
- BO: bind off

## Instructions

### Back

1. CO 60 (66) sts.
2. Work in garter stitch (k every row) for 20 (22) rows.
3. **Armhole Shaping:** BO 4 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
4. Work straight for 12 (14) rows.
5. **Shoulder Shaping:** BO 4 sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows.
6. BO the remaining 28 (30) sts.

## Front Left

1. CO 30 (33) sts.
2. Work in garter stitch for 20 (22) rows.
3. **Armhole Shaping:** BO 4 sts at the beginning of the next row.
4. Work straight for 12 (14) rows.
5. **Neck Shaping:** BO 1 st at the beginning of the next row.
6. Work straight for 4 (6) rows.
7. **Shoulder Shaping:** BO 4 sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows.
8. BO the remaining 10 (12) sts.

## Front Right

1. CO 30 (33) sts.
2. Work in garter stitch for 20 (22) rows.
3. **Armhole Shaping:** BO 4 sts at the beginning of the next row.
4. Work straight for 12 (14) rows.
5. **Neck Shaping:** BO 1 st at the end of the next row.
6. Work straight for 4 (6) rows.
7. **Shoulder Shaping:** BO 4 sts at the end of the next 4 rows.
8. BO the remaining 10 (12) sts.

## Sleeves

1. CO 34 (38) sts.

2. Work in garter stitch for 10 (12) rows.
3. **Sleeve Shaping:** Inc 1 st at each end of the next 12 (14) rows.
4. Work straight for 14 (16) rows.
5. **Cuff Shaping:** BO 4 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
6. BO the remaining 26 (30) sts.

## **Assembly**

1. Sew the shoulder seams.
2. Sew the side seams, leaving an opening for the sleeves.
3. Sew the sleeves into the armholes.
4. Sew on the buttons.

## **Finished Measurements**

- Chest circumference: 50 (54) cm
- Length: 28 (30) cm
- Sleeve length: 16 (18) cm

## **Additional Notes**

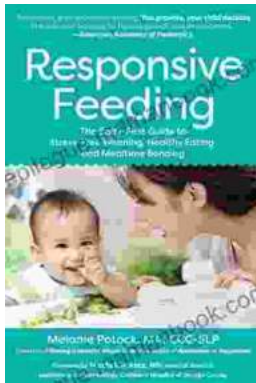
- The cardigan can be made in any color or yarn weight.
- The size can be adjusted by adding or removing stitches.
- The cardigan can be embellished with buttons, ribbons, or other embellishments.



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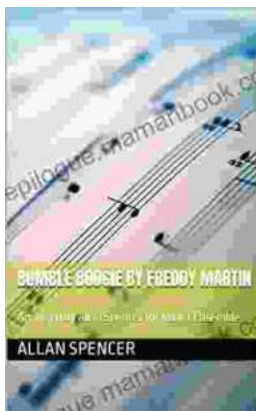
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
